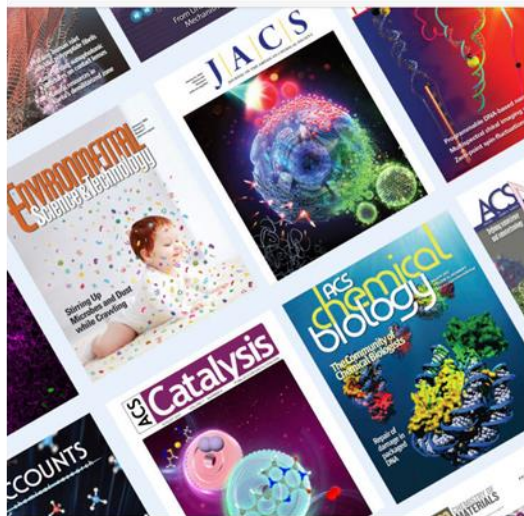

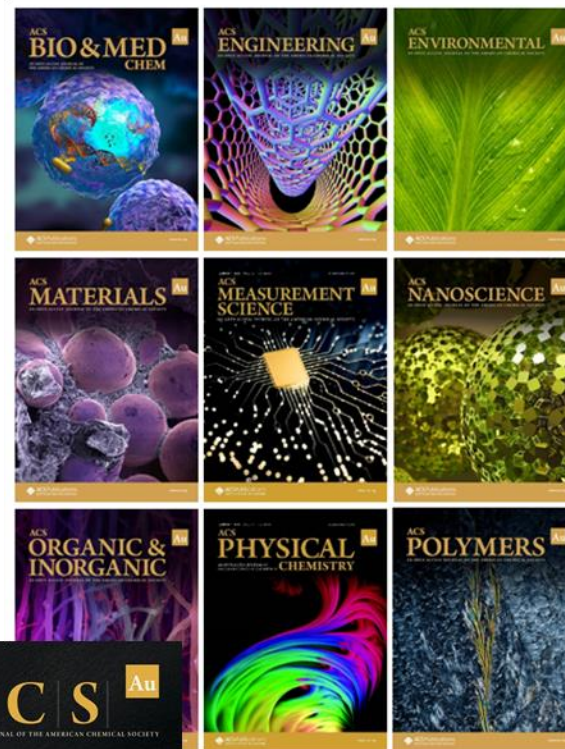

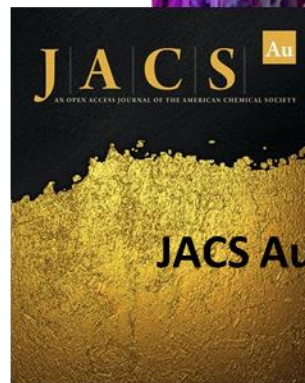

Open Access Agreements – Workflow Options – Author Experience

Touch-Free

- Automatic at manuscript acceptance
- Requires No Action from Author
- Admin gets notification of funding request only

OA Agreement – token management

Central pot of 200+ OA “tokens” each year

The tokens are managed centrally by ANKOS

All corresponding authors from institutions participating in the R+P agreement with ACS are eligible to use these tokens to publish their articles OA

Manuscript Eligibility

- **Manuscript acceptance date**

Creative Commons License

- All papers will be published with a CC-BY license

Should the tokens run out

- Profile suspended and articles will be published behind the paywall
